### **Vineyard Description:**

The Kokomo Cuvée is a unique blend of vineyards and varietals from across the North Coast. The North Coast consists of Sonoma County, Napa County, Lake County and Mendocino County and is one of the premier wine growing regions in the world. We scour this region for vineyards of distinction to showcase the versatility of the North Coast area.

### **Winemaker Notes:**

This blend is primarily made up of Carignan that comes from Tollini Vineyard in Redwood Valley. These vines are certified organic and 100% dry farmed to showcase the true essence of the varietal. The vines are 80-100 years old and have been farmed by three generations of the Tollini family. The Syrah & Petite Sirah in our Cuvée are from our home in the Dry Creek Valley.

This Rhone Blend was made in a Coté du Rhone style that comes from the southern part of the region. The main goal in this blend was to make a beautiful food wine that is very versatile and easy to drink. The acidity in this wine with the low alcohol content will allow cellaring up to 10-12 years!
